Vaccination



Vaccination is critical to protecting you and your community from the severe effects of COVID-19 and can reduce the

risk of COVID-19 transmission.

- All current and newly commencing staff must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19.
- We encourage all visitors to be fully vaccinated prior to visiting.

Record keeping



 All visitors will be required to self-screen as a minimum prior to entry at all buildings across Dhelkaya Health.

 Visitors must be honest and truthful while answering screening questions.

CHIRP

Community Health

 All visitors who have COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19 or are a close contact of someone with COVID-19 must not visit Dhelkaya Health during their 7day isolation period

Isolation



 Healthcare workers with COVID-19 or symptoms of COVID-19 should not attend work for at least 7 days or until symptoms are cleared Staff who are close

- contacts must be asymptomatic and follow testing recommendations if attending work
- Staff must notify their department manager and make plans to work from home or take leave

Staff health and wellbeing





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- All staff have access to mask fit-testing to
- accommodate their individual needs
- PPE is provided to staff

relevant to their roles

- Dhelkaya Health offers training for all staff on PPE donning and doffing and disposal relevant to their role
- ▼ During an outbreak, all clinical staff, public-facing staff and visitors must wear N95 masks in the unit which has an outbreak as a minimum requirement at all times. N95 masks are available for visitors at front

- Cleaning regimes and frequency have been increased in all areas especially at high touch communal points
- Cleaning supplies are monitored and ordered as required
